We want to give thanks to Manya and Tom Brooks, and the rest of the Carson Valley Golf Club staff for their support of the Men's Club and for keeping the course in excellent condition.

The NNGA collects your GHIN fee online, \$37, which must be paid to join the CVMC. CVMC 2025 season dues are \$30. You can pay this fee with cash or by check, through an application form attached to this letter. Additionally, there will not be a price increase for golf in 2025.

KPs and Skins will be paid out the following week in cash, rather than added to your Clubhouse account. When you arrive, you pay Chris Burner in cash for KPs (\$5) and Skins (\$10).

One change for the 2025 season will be all Tee Times are from Hole #1, no shotgun start, starting times will be on the Tee Sheet. Pay attention to your tee time and arrive at the golf course accordingly so you are not late. The Men's Club will have the first starting times of the day, so make sure you reply to the weekly round invitation prior to Friday of each round.

Tournament signups will be available every Monday on Golf Genius, and **TO PLAY ON SUNDAY YOU MUST SIGN UP BY CLOSE OF BUSINESS FRIDAY!** Events that are multiple rounds will be random pairings for the second round based on your position in the tournament.

The USGA Rules of Golf are the standard for Men's Club tournaments, so play the course as you find it and play the ball as it lies. There have been some local exceptions made per Rule 16, Abnormal Course Conditions, and these exceptions have been reviewed

with significant revisions. I have enclosed a Local Course Rules page for tournaments. I recommend you print and keep a copy in your golf bag.

Payouts go to Gross and Net Winners. The field will be divided in half each week and both halves will have a Gross division and a Net division.

There will be an equal number of gross and net payouts in each division. If a player is a winner in both divisions, they will be awarded the higher of the two payouts and will be excluded from the other division's prize fund.

We will continue to use an equitable stroke score of **15** for any hole that is not finished or scored with an (X). Hopefully this will not be necessary but it will keep a player from being disqualified completely from the tournament and allow them to possibly win something in the skins or closest to the hole portions of the event.

The following major tournaments will have added money (\$250) to the prize fund:

1. Masters
2. Vice-President's Cup
3. Club Championship
4. President's Cup

There are 4 tournaments (4-Person Scramble) with guests invited:

1. Easter Weekend (played on Saturday)
2. Mother's Day (played on Saturday)
3. Memorial Weekend (lunch provided) Charlie Poe Day (Sunday)
4. Labor Day Weekend (Sunday)

We look forward to an exciting and successful 2025 Season!
